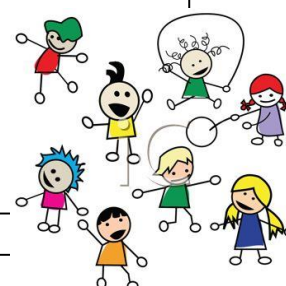

### School Uniform

***Our school uniform from Reception to Year 5 inclusive consists of:***

- Red Cardigan/Jumper with logo – only available from A & H Rosenfield
- White polo shirt – this can be plain or with the logo
- Grey trousers or shorts for boys
- Grey or red tartan skirt/pinafore or grey trousers for girls
- Red gingham summer dress for girls
- White socks or grey tights for girls, grey socks for boys
- Black shoes (not trainers)

***Our school uniform for Year 6 consists of:***

- Navy Blue jumper with logo - only available from A & H Rosenfield
- White shirt
- Red tie – only available from A & H Rosenfield
- Grey trousers or shorts for boys
- Grey skirt or trousers for girls
- White/grey socks or grey tights for girls, grey socks for boys
- Black shoes (not trainers)

The school indoor PE kit for everyone consists of white t-shirt, either plain or with the school logo, red shorts and black pumps.
