

## **Education Penalty Notice Warning for Non School Attendance**

Lowton J & I are passionate about providing your children with the very best education and it is vitally important to us that each child arrives on time and ready to learn.

The key notes to mention about our policies are that if your child falls within one or more of the following categories within a 12-week period you may receive a penalty notice: -

- 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence with under 90% attendance
- 20 sessions (10 days) of unauthorised absence
- persistently arrives late to school after the close of registration

We totally understand that you may be late on the odd occasion and it is only if this becomes a regular occurrence that it would become an issue.

## Cricket

A big thank you to Rory Kellett who has been working with the children this term. If your child has been inspired by cricket, then we have attached some information for you of how they can get involved: -

The All Stars Cricket initiative from the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) is aimed at 5-8 year olds and is designed to give them their first experience of cricket and hopefully build a new generation of life long cricket fans. All Stars Cricket is a national project with over 120 Clubs in Lancashire taking part in a specially designed 8-week programme this summer. The 2019 programmes begin from Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May.

Over the 8 weeks, children will learn the key skills of cricket (Batting, Bowling, and Fielding) as well other key life skills such as Teamwork. The programme is designed to allow every child to succeed at their own level.

The programme delivers the School Curriculum of the 12 fundamental movement skills a child needs in their physical development.

Every child who signs up for the programme will receive their own kit bag delivered to their home including:

- A Bat and Ball
- Personalised T-Shirt
- Cap
- Activity Book
