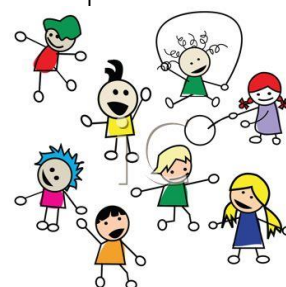

Please can you send any outstanding sponsor money into school as soon as possible after the half term holiday. We will then be able to tell you the total raised. Thank you.



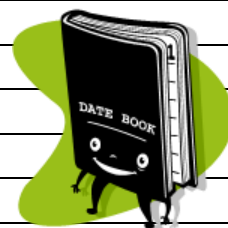
At Lowton J & I we aim for all children to have 96% attendance or over.
