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Education Penalty Notice Warning for Non School Attendance

Lowton J & I are passionate about providing your children with the very best education and it is vitally important to us that each child arrives on time and ready to learn.

The key notes to mention about our policies are that if your child falls within one or more of the following categories within a 12-week period you may receive a penalty notice: -

- 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence with under 90% attendance
- 20 sessions (10 days) of unauthorised absence
- persistently arrives late to school after the close of registration

We totally understand that you may be late on the odd occasion and it is only if this becomes a regular occurrence that it would become an issue.

Car Parking

We have already started to receive complaints in the school office about the parking at drop off and pick up time.

Please can you ensure that you park legally and considerately at all time in the local area. The gym car park is a PRIVATE car park and must not be used.

As always, I have advised the local business and residents to contact the police and traffic wardens with registration numbers if they feel any parking laws have been broken.
